

ONEBOOKAZ Step by Step download instructions
Using title Corr Syl the Warrior as an example

For the Apple iPad or Apple iPhone, follow these directions

1. On your iPad, open "Safari" and go to <http://www.onebookaz.org> (the www portion of the address MUST be typed in)
2. Tap the link "Download here"
3. Tap the "All other eReaders" link for Corr Syl the Warrior
4. Tap the "Open in iBooks" button.
5. The file should download to your iPad and the iBooks Reader app should open with the book already on the "shelf". Then the book itself will automatically open.

For the e-ink (B&W) Kindle or Kindle Paperwhite, follow these directions

1. With a computer, go to <http://www.onebookaz.org> (the www portion of the address MUST be typed in)
2. Click the link "Download here"
3. Click the "Kindle" link for Corr Syl the Warrior
4. Save it to the "Downloads" folder on your computer. The file should download to your computer.
5. Open the "Downloads" folder on your computer and copy the "Corr-Syl-the-Warrior.mobi" file.
6. Connect your Kindle or Kindle Paperwhite to your computer with the USB cable
7. A window should appear on your computer asking what you want to do with the Kindle Fire. Click "Open device to view files".
8. Open the "Documents" folder
9. Paste the "Corr-Syl-the-Warrior.mobi" file to the "Documents" folder on the Kindle
10. Use the "Safely Remove Hardware and Eject Media" button in the notification area on a Windows computer (the Mac has a similar button) and Eject the Kindle or Kindle Paperwhite.
11. The book should be listed in your list of books on the Kindle or Kindle Paperwhite.

For the Kindle Fire, Fire HD, and Fire HDX

1. On your computer, go to <http://www.onebookaz.org> (the www portion of the address MUST be typed in)
2. Click the link "Download here"
3. Click the "Kindle" link for Corr Syl the Warrior
4. Save it to the "Downloads" folder on your computer. The file should download to your computer.
5. Open the "Downloads" folder on your computer and copy the "Corr-Syl-the-Warrior.mobi" file.
6. Connect your Kindle Fire to your computer with the USB cable
7. A window should appear on your computer asking what you want to do with the Kindle Fire. Click "Open device to view files".
8. Open the "Internal Storage" folder. Then open the "Books" folder (located inside of the "Internal Storage" folder).
9. Paste the "Corr-Syl-the-Warrior.mobi" file from your computer to the "Books" folder on the Kindle Fire

10. Use the "Safely Remove Hardware and Eject Media" button in the notification area on a Windows computer (the Mac has a similar button) and Eject the Kindle Fire.
11. The book should now appear in the Book section of your Kindle Fire. To see it, tap "Books" on the Kindle Fire. Tap the book to open it.

For the e-ink (B&W) Nook or Nook Glowlight

1. On your computer, go to <http://www.onebookaz.org> (the www portion of the address MUST be typed in)
2. Click the link "Download here"
3. Click the "All other eReaders" link for Corr Syl the Warrior
4. Save it to the "Downloads" folder on your computer. The file should download to your computer.
5. Open the "Downloads" folder on your computer and copy the "Corr-Syl-the-Warrior.epub" file.
6. Connect your Nook to your computer with the USB cable
7. A window should appear on your computer asking what you want to do with the Nook. Click "Open device to view files".
8. Open the "My Files" folder and then open the "Books" folder (which is inside the "My Files" folder)
9. Paste the "Corr-Syl-the-Warrior.epub" file into the "Books" folder on the Nook
10. Use the "Safely Remove Hardware and Eject Media" button in the notification area on a Windows computer (the Mac has a similar button) and Eject the Nook or Nook Glowlight.
11. To see the book, tap the "Library" button on the main menu. It will probably be listed on the last page of books. Tap the book to see it.

For the Nook Color, Nook Tablet, Nook Tablet HD, and Nook Tablet HD+

1. On your computer, go to <http://www.onebookaz.org> (the www portion of the address MUST be typed in)
2. Click the link "Download here"
3. Click the "All other eReaders" link for Corr Syl the Warrior
4. Save it to the "Downloads" folder on your computer. The file should download to your computer.
5. Open the "Downloads" folder on your computer and copy the "Corr-Syl-the-Warrior.epub" file.
6. Connect your Nook Color or Nook Tablet to your computer with the USB cable
7. A window should appear on your computer asking what you want to do with the Nook. Click "Open device to view files".
8. Open the "Internal Storage folder". Then open the "My Files" folder (inside of "Internal Storage Folder) and then the "Books" folder (which is inside the "My Files" folder).
9. Paste file "Corr-Syl-the-Warrior.epub" file into the "Books" folder on the Nook
10. Use the "Safely Remove Hardware and Eject Media" button in the notification area on a Windows computer (the Mac has a similar button) and Eject the Nook Color or Nook Tablet.
11. On the Nook, you should find the book under the "Library" section - in "My Files". Tap the book. Then tap "Reader". The book will open. In the future, you should see the book under the Book section in the Library.

For a Droid Tablet or phone, follow these directions

You must install a book app, such as the OverDrive Media Console for Droid, to make this work. Another book app might work. But, these instructions are for OverDrive. To get OverDrive Media Console on your Droid tablet/phone, open the "Play Store" and download & install OverDrive Media Console. Then follow these directions:

1. On your Droid device, open the Internet and go to <http://www.onebookaz.org> (the www portion of the address MUST be typed in)
2. Tap the link "Download here"
3. Tap the "All other eReaders" link for Corr Syl the Warrior
4. A message will state that the book is downloading.
5. Tap the "Home" button to get back to the desktop
6. In the list of apps, tap the "Downloads" app
7. Tap the book
8. OverDrive should open with the book cover showing. Tap the book to read it.
9. To read the book in the future, open "OverDrive Media Console" in the list of apps.
