Snowflake/Taylor Recreation and Parks Department is offering Hula lessons for girls and boys this summer. Do you want to have fun and learn how to dance hula? Come out and learn about Hawaiian Hula and a little bit about the Hawaiian Culture. In this 6 week course you will be intruduced to basic hula movements, utilizing them to perform modern stylehulas ('Auana) and you will also learn a few Hawaiian Words. Classes will start using very basic moves (hand and feet placement) and progress to using a series of those movements to complete a dance. Classes will be at **Highland Primary** and will run for 6 weeks. The class instructor is Lauri Wong who has over 40 years of experience.
